Our Services for Adults and Pediatrics

NURSING CARE

RN's and LPN's provide direct nursing care and collaborate with the patients and their physician to develop an appropriate and comprehensive plan of care.

Specialized nursing services include wound and ostomy care, and infusion therapy. Nursing Assistants provide help with personal care and light housekeeping in collaboration with nursing and therapy services.

REHABILITATIVE THERAPY

Rehabilitative services are provided by our physical, occupational and speech language therapists. Our therapists educate and assist patients to regain their maximum physical capabilities and achieve their highest level of independence.

They may assist patients in day-to-day activities and educate them on creating a safe home environment. Speech therapists may also assist patients in re-establishing and regaining their speaking ability.
